Tired of the gray academic speeches and the soporific tones with which they usually transmit, she got down to work and in 2015 she opened a channel on YouTube.
















"I wanted to bring art and its history closer to people of all ages in a fun but rigorous way. It already has more than 92,000 subscribers", she said.














A few words about the project

The project consortium comprises key academics, investors, industry/employment associations, startup associations, and societal growth partners (and associated partners) from different sectors who will co-create the envisaged

















DREP curriculum and will pilot it through an open innovation and co-creation virtual learning environment (VLE).
